

The Venetian Pool is fed by spring water from an underground aquifer and is refilled daily, with over 820,000 gallons of water. The pool features two waterfalls and cave-like grottos for a fun experience for all swimmers.



#### **Wynwood Walls**

The Salty is a family-owned, artisan donut shop that focuses on chef-made, small-batch, craft donuts that rotate based on seasonality. Wynwood Walls in Miami is an intriguing artistic spot. The collection of murals and street art on display is diverse and engaging. Walking through this outdoor gallery provides an interesting glimpse into various artistic styles and stories.
