Campers learn all about simple machines by engaging in hands-on activities to discover their inner workings, then using what they have learned to design and invent their own machines.



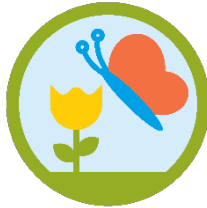

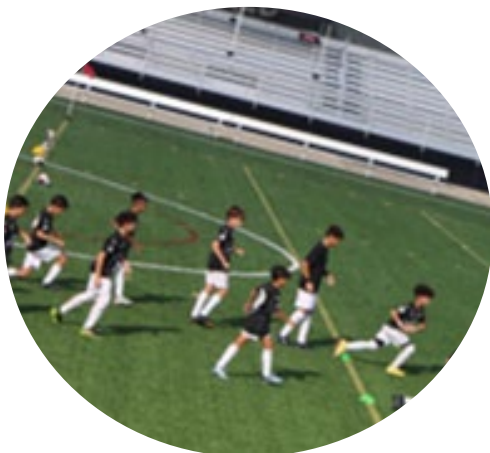
