## **Technology Requirements 2026-27**

### **Grades K-5**

Students entering Sagemont Prep K through 5 are issued an Apple iPad to enrich their daily learning experience. All Sagemont Prep Students must purchase an iPad cover with a keyboard for their designated iPad model. Screen protectors are highly encouraged. All K-5 Students must purchase Bluetooth headphones for their iPads. Because new Apple devices are being made without an aux jack, the best way to support them is to use Bluetooth headphones.

*\*Please do not purchase any iPad keyboard covers until iPad agreements have been sent home with the appropriate iPad information per student.*

### **Grades 6-12**

Students entering Sagemont Prep 6-12 are required to bring their own laptop device. ThinkPads are recommended devices. Devices should have at least 8GB of Memory, a 128GB SSD (Drive Space), 802.11 Wireless Networking, and OS X 10.14 or higher. Chromebooks are NOT recommended for grades 9-12 as they are not compatible with AP exam software and college entrance exam software. Apple/Mac devices are NOT recommended.

### **Civil and Aerospace Engineering & Architecture Students**

If a middle/high school student is taking civil engineering and/or architecture, Apple/Mac devices and Chromebooks are not compatible. Any other PC with at least 8-16GB of memory and 250-500 GB SSD (Drive Space) is preferred. All appropriate software will be downloaded with the teachers.

### **Computer Science, Robotics & Film Program Students**

If a middle/high school student is taking computer science, robotics and/or film courses, Chromebooks are not compatible. Any PC with at least 8-16GB of memory and 250-500 GB SSd (Drive Space) is preferred. All appropriate software will be downloaded with the teachers. \*These students will also need a USB with at least 32GB memory and a pair of headphones.

## **Recommended iPad Covers**

- All cases should include a keyboard.
- Please do not purchase any iPad keyboard covers until iPad agreements have been sent home with the appropriate iPad information per student.
- Please note that if students received an iPad last year and turned it in undamaged, they will receive the same iPad; therefore, their old case can be used if it includes a keyboard.
