Late Pick-Up Policy: Students must be picked up promptly at dismissal. A late fee of \$5 per minute, per child will be assessed for every minute a student remains on campus after dismissal beginning at 3:15 PM. For students enrolled in Aftercare, a late fee of \$5 per minute, per child will be assessed for every minute after 6:00 PM.

To avoid late pick-up charges after the regular school day, parents may utilize our Aftercare Program on a drop-in basis for \$50 per day, provided space is available. Enrollment in Aftercare must be arranged prior to dismissal. Repeated late pick-ups may result in additional administrative review.

Math Olympiads, MOEMS

Grades: 4th - 5th

MOEMS aims to foster a love for mathematics by introducing key concepts, innovative problem-solving strategies, and developing creativity and intuition. MOEMS offers engaging contests from November through March featuring unique problems and detailed solutions. These contests provide a stimulating and rewarding experience, significantly enhancing students' problem-solving skills and deepening their appreciation for mathematics.

Sagemont Prep VEX Robotics Competitive Team

Grade Levels: 3rd - 5th

Join the Lion Innovators, Sagemont Prep's competitive VEX Robotics team, and dive into the exciting world of robotics, innovation, and teamwork! Designed for motivated 3rd - 5th grade students, this program offers hands-on experience with building and programming robots while preparing for this year's VEX IQ challenge, "Mix and Match." Environmental Club

Open to students in Kindergarten through 5th Grade, the Swim Team provides athletes with the opportunity to develop stroke technique, build endurance, improve water safety skills, and gain confidence in a fun and supportive team environment. Through structured practices and expert coaching, swimmers will strengthen their abilities while learning the values of teamwork, perseverance, and sportsmanship.

Participation on the Swim Team requires a tryout, and team members will practice every Monday and Wednesday throughout the season. As members of the SFRSL (South Florida Recreational Swim League), swimmers will compete against other local teams in exciting swim meets beginning after November, giving them the opportunity to challenge themselves, achieve personal goals, and represent their school with pride.

Our Little Lion Cheerleaders program introduces students to the fun and excitement of cheerleading while building confidence, teamwork, and school spirit.
