Preschool Supply List

- A FULL change of clothes to be left at school: **LABELED** with your child's name inside each item. (shirt, shorts, underwear, socks, shoes)
- An *old*, adult's **T-shirt** - to be used for a smock (please be aware, it may be cut to fit)
- **LARGE BACKPACK** (that can carry blankets, swim change, take-home folder, and other items on a daily basis). **PLEASE NO ROLLING BACKPACKS.**
- Sleep Mat (for rest time) - plastic fold-over and at least **2" thick**. Found at AC Moore or ACE Educational. (Not the kind used for exercise.)
- Blanket - **small** for rest time (no fitted sheets)
- Elmer's school glue - two bottles (please not generic brand)
- Elmer's glue sticks - six **LARGE PURPLE** (washable only)
- Crayola crayons - one box of large size (classic colors)
- Crayola crayons - two boxes of regular size (classis colors)*
- Crayola markers - one box of large size (classic colors)
- Scissors - one pair of children's blunt edge FISKARS
- Baby Wipes – UNSCENTED one container and **five** refill packages*
- Kleenex tissues - one box
- Lysol Wipes - 3 containers*
- Hand Sanitizer - one pump bottle (unscented if possible)
- Ziploc bags - one box of gallon size
- Ziploc bags - two boxes of sandwich size
- WHITE T-shirt - plain (a size bigger than your child's current size – no pockets, no designs)

PLEASE BE SURE TO CLEARLY LABEL ALL CLOTHING ITEMS, BLANKETS, BACKPACKS, SWIMMING TOWELS, ETC. IN LARGE, LEGIBLE LETTERS

(No need to label crayons, markers, glue, scissors, wipes, tissues, Zip-lock bags, and hand sanitizer. These items are used as a community during lessons and clean-up.)

* Denotes items that will be given to specialists to share school wide.
