



International Student Check List

STEP 1

- Application completed - must have foreign and local address complete
- Translated report cards for three years prior to current grade- must be originals
- Letters of recommendation from math and language arts teachers and administrator (Forms on website)
- Recent TOEFL or IELTS scores
- Copy of Passport
- Biographical essay (200 words) including pictures, introducing yourself to Sagemont and host family
- SKYPE interview

STEP 2

After admission review and acceptance is confirmed, I-20 will be completed once received:

- \$3,400 for application fee, new/annual student fee and registration fee

STEP 3

- Copy of Immunization Schedule from home country. Required vaccinations must be complete prior to arrival
- \$250 may be required to have foreign credit hours transferred to a US transcript by EDU Evaluations
- Athlete's Only: FHSAA, Preparation Physical Evaluation Form EL2 must be completed by a Florida Doctor after you complete Consent and Release from Liability Certificate, Form EL3
- Athlete's Only: complete Registration of Foreign Exchange Student and Other International Student, Form EL4
- Grades 9-12 require a MacBook (please refer to technology requirements on website)
- Sagemont School documents read, reviewed and signed
