

Immunizations required for enrollment!

Keeping students healthy and free from infectious disease is extremely important; therefore, before starting school **students must** have the proper immunizations.

Minimum required immunizations for kindergarten students:

- Diphtheria Tetanus Pertussis (DTaP) 5 doses
- Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) 4 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 dose
- Hepatitis B series 3 doses
(can take up to 6 months to complete)
- *Varicella Vaccine 1 dose

Minimum requirements for students entering 7th - 12th Grades:

- Hepatitis B series (3 doses which take 6 months to complete)
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis Booster (Tdap)
- Measles – 2nd dose (preferably MMR)
- 2 doses Varicella Vaccine

** Varicella vaccine is not required if there is a history of varicella disease documented by the healthcare provider.*

Immunizations must be documented on **Florida Certificate of Immunization, Form 680.**

Additionally, students entering 7th grade ***must be screened for Scoliosis*** and present the **School Entry Health Exam** document as well as the Certificate of Immunization the first day of school. These forms are supplied by your health care provider or you can go to:
