FUN MATH ACTIVITIES TO ENJOY DURING THE SUMMER AND GET READY TO BEGIN PRE- KINDERGARTEN!

COLORS

- *FIND THE COLORS IN YOUR BEDROOM.
- *ASK YOUR CHILD TO BRING YOU THE “*YELLOW*” SHIRT (YOU CAN CHANGE THE COLORS EACH TIME).
- *ASK YOUR CHILD TO TELL AND SHOW YOU HIS/HER FAVORITE COLOR.
- *WHEN TALKING TO YOUR CHILD, ASK YOUR CHILD THE COLOR OF THINGS AROUND THEM.
- *ORGANIZE TOYS ACCORDING TO THEIR COLOR.
- *MAKE PATTERNS USING 2 OR 3 DIFFERENT COLORS (**RED**, **BLUE**, **GREEN**, **RED**, **BLUE**, **GREEN**, **RED**, ETC.)

COUNTING

- *LET’S COUNT TO 10 STARTING WITH 1.
- *LET’S START WITH 3 AND COUNT TO 8, ETC.
- *YOUR CHILD LISTENS AS YOU SLOWLY CLAP OR STOMP OUT THE VALUE OF A NUMBER. YOU CAN TAKE TURNS TO BE THE LEADER.
- *DID I DO IT RIGHT?
I’M GOING TO COUNT TO 5: 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 5. DID I DO IT RIGHT?
(NO)
HOW WOULD YOU COUNT TO 5?
- *COUNT THE NUMBER OF STEPS FROM YOUR BEDROOM TO THE KITCHEN.
- *COUNT THE NUMBER OF EGGS YOU HAVE IN THE REFRIGERATOR.
- *COUNT THE NUMBER OF BANANAS YOU ARE BUYING AT THE GROCERY STORE.
- *ASK YOUR CHILD TO GIVE YOU *A NUMBER* OF PEBBLES.
PLEASE GIVE ME 3 PEBBLES, 5 BUTTONS, 1 CRAYON, ETC.

***SHOW A NUMBER CARD TO YOUR CHILD AND TELL HIM/HER TO GIVE YOU THE CORRESPONDING QUANTITY OF ITEMS (1 – 10).**

NUMBER RECOGNITION

WHEN HAVE YOU USED NUMBERS TODAY? (COUNTING MONEY, LOOKING AT THE CLOCK OR CALENDAR, ETC.)

***USING FLASHCARDS FIND DIFFERENT NUMBERS 1 – 10**

***MATCH UP GAME: YOU NEED 2 SETS OF CARDS 1 – 10. LAY OUT ALL OF THE CARDS FACE DOWN AND TRY TO MATCH EACH CARD WITH ITS PARTNER.**

***ORDER IT: YOU NEED A SET OF FLASHCARDS 1 – 10. MIX UP THE DECK OF CARDS AND LAY THEM OUT ON A FLAT SURFACE. HAVE YOUR CHILD PRACTICE ORDERING NUMBERS BY PICKING UP THE CARDS AND PUTTING THEM IN ORDER FROM 1 – 10.**

NUMBER WRITING

***HAVE YOUR CHILD TRACE LARGE NUMBERS IN THE AIR.**

***HAVE YOUR CHILD WRITE NUMBERS WITH SHAVING CREAM.**

***HAVE YOUR CHILD TRACE THE NUMBER FOLLOWING THE DOTTED LINES.**

***HAVE YOUR CHILD WRITE NUMBERS FREELY ON A PIECE OF PAPER.**
