## *CSI NEW RIVER*

In this educational program, students will delve into the Cooley incident on the New River from a forensic anthropologist and bio-archaeologist perspective. They will analyze the circumstances that resulted in the tragic demise of William Cooley's family and their tutor, Joseph Flinton. The program will cover how skeletal markers are used by forensic teams to determine the cause of death of the Cooley family. Students will also learn about the methods used by CSI teams to gather and interpret evidence and how this evidence is utilized in criminal investigations.
