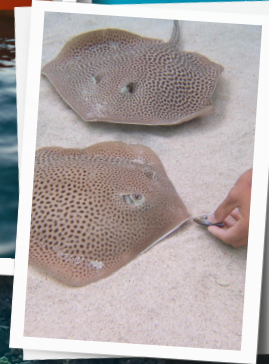


UNDER THE SEA

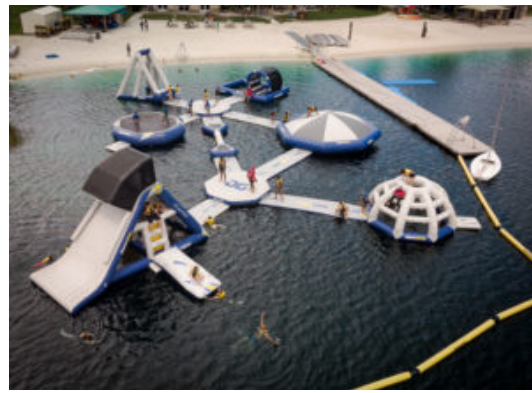
